

## COURT OF BIH

### WEEKLY REVIEW OF ACTIVITIES

#### Sections I, II and III

(13-17 May 2024)

- On 18 April 2024, the Court confirmed an indictment in the case of **Ljiljana Burić (S1 3 K 047956 24 Kps)**, charging the accused **Ljiljana Burić** that, by the acts described in the indictment, she committed the criminal offense of Money Forfeiture under Article 205(1) of the Criminal Code of Bosnia and Herzegovina (CC BiH).

The indictment alleges that, on 16 September 2023 in Brčko, intending to place false money into circulation as genuine, having obtained in the manner known to her a false banknote in denomination of **100.00 BAM**, the accused visited a pharmacy PZU Apoteka "I. S." Tuzla in Brčko with the intent to pay the purchased articles, gave to a worker the banknote of **100.00 BAM**, having known that it was a forged one.

- On 25 April 2024, the Court confirmed an indictment in the case of **Armin Bureić (S1 3 K 046133 24 Kps)**, charging the accused **Armin Bureić** that, with the acts described in the indictment, he committed the criminal offense of Smuggling of Persons under Article 189(2) of the CC BiH.

The indictment alleges that, on 20 July 2023, in the afternoon hours, in the BiH territory, being aware that he was transporting smuggled persons, and knowing that they had not satisfied the requirements for a lawful stay in the BiH territory, with the aim to obtain unlawful property gain, the accused has agreed with persons known to him to transport four foreign nationals in total, who had been smuggled from the territory of Montenegro to BiH. The indictment further alleges that the accused drove to the territory of Čajniče municipality, where he took over the smuggled persons into a personal motor vehicle and attempted to transfer them over to the territory of the City of Sarajevo.

- In ruling on a motion filed by the BiH Prosecutor's Office, on 10 May 2024, the Court issued a decision in the case of **Kalamanda Tovilović Stefan Mariano et al. (S1 3 K 047923 24 Kpp)** extending custody of the suspects **Kalamanda**

**Tovilović Stefan Mariano and Okorn Art**, which can last, pursuant to the said decision, no longer than **2 (two) months**, that is, until **10 July 2024** or a new Court's decision, due to the existing particular custody grounds set forth in Article 132(1) a) of the CPC BiH, that is, due to a risk of flight.

The suspects have been charged with the criminal offense of Money Forfeiture under Article 205(1) of the CC BiH, as read with Article 54 of the CC BiH, all as read with Article 29 of the same Code.

- On 10 May 2024, having held a hearing in the case of **Ivica Matković (S1 3 K 043867 24 Eks)**, within the procedure to extradite the requested person **Ivica Matković**, pursuant to an international red notice issued by the NCB Interpol Zagreb, Republic Croatia, namely NCB Interpol Sarajevo, the Court issued a decision ordering the requested person **Ivica Matković** into **extradition custody**, which can pursuant to this decision last no longer than **6 (six) months** running from the arrest day, that is, until **8 November 2024** or a new Court's decision.

**MONDAY, 13 May 2024**

- Having accepted a guilty plea agreement in the case of **Orhan Babić et al. (S1 3 K 047559 24 Kps)**, the Court delivered, on 13 May 2024, a judgment finding the accused **Orhan Babić and Sead Hajrić guilty** of the criminal offense of Money Forfeiture under Article 205(1) of the CC BiH, as read with Articles 26 and 29 of the same Code.

For the committed criminal offenses, the Court imposed on the two accused **suspended sentences** of imprisonment for a term of **1 (one) year each**, having also ordered that the sentence will not be executed unless the two accused commit a new criminal offense within a period of 2 (two) years after the judgment's finality.

Based on the legal provisions, the instrumentality used for the crime commission shall be confiscated from the accused **Orhan Babić**, that is, a forged banknote in denomination of **50.00 BAM**.

**TUESDAY, 14 May 2024**

- At the arraignment held on 14 May 2024 in the case of **Siniša Simikić (S1 2 K 043203 24 Ko)**, the accused **Siniša Simikić** pled **not guilty** of the criminal offense charged against him under the indictment of the BiH Prosecutor's Office – Tax Evasion or Fraud under Article 210(4) in conjunction with Paragraph 1 of the CC BiH.
- At the arraignment held on 14 May 2024 in the case of **Vinko Radović et al. (S1 1 K 047153 23 Kro)** the accused **Vinko Radović and Dragomir Vasić** pled **not guilty** of the criminal offense charged against them under the indictment of the BiH Prosecutor's Office – Crimes against Humanity under Article 172 d), and the accused **Petko Panić** of the criminal offense of Crimes against Humanity under Article 172 d), e) and k) of the CC BiH, as read with Article 180(1) and Articles 31 and 180 of the CC BiH.
- Having accepted a guilty plea agreement in the case of **Hamit Yildirim (S1 2 K 047768 24 Ko)**, the Court delivered, on 14 May 2024, a judgment finding the accused **Hamit Yildirim guilty** of the criminal offense of Giving Gifts and Other Forms of Benefit under Article 218(1) of the CC BiH.

The Court imposed on the accused for the committed crime a suspended sentence of imprisonment for a term of **eight (8) months**, having also ordered that the sentence will not be executed unless the accused commits a new criminal offense within a period of **one (1) year and six (6) months** after the judgment's finality. In addition, the Court fined the accused in the amount of **1,500.00 BAM**, which shall be paid by the accused towards the BiH budget.

The accused has been charged that, on 27 March 2024, on the official premises of the BiH Border Police, Police Border Unit of the Airport Sarajevo, having arrived on a flight from Istanbul, Turkiye, he approached border checking desks, and during control by authorized official persons of the BiH Border Police, knowing that he did not satisfy the BiH entry requirements because he had not possessed enough means of support during the intended stay in BiH, being aware of his unlawful acts and wanting them, the accused offered a money gift to the police officer of the Border Police performing the border checking. The indictment further alleges that the accused offered the gift with the intent that the referenced police officer perform an act within his official powers which he ought not perform, namely to allow him entry in BiH in contravention of the Law on Aliens and the provisions of the Book of Rules

concerning the Entry and Stay of Aliens, which the police officer ultimately refused to perform.

- On 14 May 2023 the Court of Bosnia and Herzegovina delivered a Trial Judgment in the case of **Ivan Antunović et al. (S1 2 K 032139 20 K)**, which found **the accused Ivan Antunović, Borislav Kovačević, Mario Vuletić and Haris Hodžić guilty** that by the acts described in the convicting part of the Judgment they committed the offenses as follows:
  - the accused **Ivan Antunović**, as the person who organized and led a group for organized crime – the criminal offense of Organized Crime under Article 250(3) CC BiH, as read with the criminal offense of Illicit Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs under Article 195(1) CC BiH;
  - the accused **Borislav Kovačević, Mario Vuletić and Haris Hodžić**, as members of the group for organized crime, the criminal offense of Organized Crime under Article 250(2) CC BiH, as read with the criminal offense of Illicit Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs under Article 195(1) of the Code.

**The Court imposed on the accused the following sentences of imprisonment:**

- the accused **Ivan Antunović**, as the person who organized and led the group for organized crime, a sentence of **fourteen (14) years of imprisonment**, with the time he spent in pre-trial custody, specifically from **10 March 2020 to 23 September 2020 and from 28 October 2020 to 5 January 2021**, being credited towards his sentence of imprisonment. The accused was also fined with **100,000.00 BAM**;
- the accused **Borislav Kovačević**, as a member of the group for organized crime, a sentence of **six (6) years of imprisonment**, with the time he spent in pre-trial custody, specifically from 10 March 2020 to 4 September 2020, being credited towards his sentence of imprisonment.
- the accused **Mario Vuletić**, as a member of the group for organized crime, a sentence of **seven (7) years of imprisonment**, with the time he spent in pre-trial custody, specifically from 14 February 2019 to 13 March 2019, being credited towards his sentence of imprisonment.
- the accused **Haris Hodžić**, as a member of the group for organized crime, a sentence of **seven (7) years of imprisonment**, with the time he spent in

pre-trial custody, specifically from 10 March 2020 to 10 April 2020, being credited towards his sentence of imprisonment.

At the same time, the ill-gotten gain shall be confiscated from the accused as follows:

- from the accused **Ivan Antunović** - **230,305.00 EUR**, **69,830.00 BAM** and **55,780.00 BAM**;
- from the accused **Borislav Kovačević** - **500.00 EUR** and **600.00 BAM**;
- from the accused **Mario Vuletić** - **112,800.00 EUR**;
- from the accused **Haris Hodžić** - **213,000.00 EUR**.

Pursuant to **Article 284 c) of the CPC BiH**, the Court **acquitted** the accused **Ivan Antunović, Borislav Kovačević and Nikola Bošković of the charges** for the commission of certain criminal offenses under certain sections of the acquitting part of the judgment's operative part.

Under the same judgment, pursuant to **Article 283(1) e) of the CPC BIH**, the Court **dismissed the charges** against the accused **Ivan Antunović, Borislav Kovačević and Nikola Bošković** in relation to certain sections in the dismissing part of the judgment's operative part related to the criminal offense of Organized Crime under Article 250(2) and (3) of the CC BiH, in connection with the criminal offense of Illicit Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs under Article 195(1) of the CC BiH.

An appeal from the referenced judgment may be filed with the Court's Appellate Division within 15 days after the receipt of a written copy of the judgment.

**WEDNESDAY, 15 May 2024**

- Ruling on the Prosecutor's Motion filed in the case of **Sufian Ali et al. (S1 2 K 047964 24 Krn)**, on 15 May 2024 the Court issued a Decision remanding the suspects **Sufian Ali and Waker Ali in continued custody**, so that according to the Decision it may last for a maximum of **2 (two) months**, i.e. until **15 July 2024** or until the Court issues a new decision, all on the grounds referred to in Article 132(1) a) CPC BiH, i.e. flight risk.
- On 15 May 2024 the Court issued a Decision in the case of **Edin Podgora (S1 2 K 047975 24 Kv 2)** granting the Prosecutor's Motion, and remanded the suspect **Edin Podgor in continued custody**, originally ordered by a

previous decision of the Court, so that according to the Decision it may last for a maximum of **2 (two) months**, i.e. until **15 July 2024** or until the Court issues a new decision, all on the grounds referred to in Article 132(1), Subparagraphs c) and d), of the CPC BiH.

- At the arraignment held on 15 May 2024 in the case of **Boban Janjić (S1 2 K 046530 24 Ko)**, the accused **Boban Janjić** entered a **plea of guilty** under the Indictment charging him with the criminal offense of Illicit Trade in Excise Products under Article 210a(1) CC BiH, as read with Article 26 of the Code.

**THURSDAY, 16 May 2024**

- Ruling on Prosecutor's Motion filed in the case of **Ameer Maib S1 3 K 047548 24 Kv 3**, on 16 May 2024 the Court issued a Decision remanding the suspect **Ameer Maib in continued custody** following Indictment confirmation, so that according to the Decision it may last until a trial judgment is delivered or until the Court issues a new decision in the matter, but not longer than **(1) year and six (6) months**, i.e. until **13 November 2025**, on proviso that the control of custody justifiability be carried out on a bimonthly basis.
- Having granted a guilty plea agreement in the case of **Mladen Nikačević (S1 2 K 048002 24 Ko)**, on 16 May 2024 the Court delivered a Judgment finding the accused **Mladen Nikačević guilty** of the criminal offense of Organising a Group or Association for Smuggling or Distribution of Goods on Which Duties Were Not Paid under Article 215(2) CC BiH, as read with the criminal offense of Smuggling under Article 214(1) of the Code, all in conjunction with Articles 31 and 54 CC BiH.

The Court sentenced the accused to **one (1) year of imprisonment**, and also fined him with **20,000.00 BAM**, which the accused shall pay within 6 (six) months of the day when the Judgment becomes final. The ill-gotten gain in the amount of **69,500.00 BAM** shall be confiscated from the accused Mladen Nikačević.

The accused has been found guilty because, in pursuing his own interest, collecting monetary compensation for certifying fictitious documents in the name of the legal entity Nikačević Logistics d.o.o. Kiseljak, operating as a member of a group organized by R.D., and acting on his orders, he enabled D.O. and M.O. to bring into BiH physically, across a customs line, hidden uncleared goods/raw coffee, which they resold at the market and obtained ill-gotten gain for the group, without the legal entity Nikačević Logistics d.o.o. Kiseljak ever having the goods at their disposal. It is further said that Mladen Nikačević had also undertaken the acts of fictitious debt settlement on behalf of the legal entity Nikačević Logistics d.o.o. Kiseljak in order to conceal the original illegal and undeclared import of raw coffee into Bosnia and Herzegovina.

- At the arraignment held on 16 May 2024 in the case of **Vasvija Vidović (S1 3 K 047098 24 Kps)**, the accused **Vasvija Vidović** entered a not guilty plea under the Indictment issued by the BiH Prosecutor's Office, which charges her with the criminal offense of Tampering with Evidence under Article 236(2) CC BiH.
- In the case of **Mato Šarić (S1 3 K 047910 24 Eks)**, the procedure of extradition of the requested person **Mate Šarić**, under an international red notice issued by the NCB Interpol Zagreb, Croatia, and the NCB Interpol Sarajevo, having held a hearing, on 16 May 2024 the Court issued a Decision remanding the requested person **Mate Šarić** in **extradition custody**, which under the Decision may last for a maximum of 6 (six) months, running from the day of arrest, i.e. until **11 October 2024** or until the Court issues a new decision.
