IN THE NAME OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

The Court of Bosnia and Herzegovina, sitting as the Panel composed of Judge Ljubomir Kitić as the Presiding Judge and Judges Šaban Maksumić and Nenad Šešeda as members of the Panel, with the participation of the court officer Lana Ferović as the record-taker, in the criminal case against the accused Željko Ilić for the criminal offence of Organised Crime under Article 250 (3) of the Criminal Code of Bosnia and Herzegovina (the CC of B-H), in conjunction with the criminal offence of Illicit Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs under Article 195 (1) of the CC of B-H, upon the Indictment of the Prosecutor's Office of Bosnia and Herzegovina, Special Department for Organised Crime, Economic Crime and Corruption number KT-339/08 of 20 February 2009, following the oral and public hearing regarding the Plea Agreement, in the presence of the prosecutor of the Prosecutor's Office of B-H Diana Kajmaković, the accused Željko Ilić and his defence counsel, lawyer Midhat Kočo, reached and on 22 September 2009 publicly announced the following:

VERDICT

ŽELJKO ILIĆ, a.k.a. Kosijer, son of Danilo and Milosavka, nee Vujović, born on 4 January 1965 in the village of Dola, municipality of Bileća, with residence in Bileća, Stepe Stepanovića Street bb /no number/, citizen of BiH, Personal Identification Number 0401965151006, under the Verdict by the Bileća Military Court of 24 January 1995 convicted of the criminal offence of Illicit Possession of Weapons or Explosive Substances under Article 213 (1) of the RS CC and sentenced to three months of imprisonment, one year on probation; under the Verdict by the Trebinje Basic Court of 3 March 2000 convicted of the criminal offence of Illicit Production and Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs under Article 245 (1) of the RS CC and sentenced to seven months of imprisonment; under the Verdict by the Trebinje Basic Court of 13 May 2004 convicted of the criminal offence of Illicit Manufacturing and Trade of Weapons or Explosive Substances under Article 399 (1) of the RS CC and sentenced to three months of imprisonment, one year on probation; and under the Verdict by the Banjaluka District Court number 011-O-K-08-000-006-P of 8 July 2008 convicted of the criminal offence of Organised Crime under Article 383 (2) (a) of the RS CC, in conjunction with the criminal offence of Illicit Production and Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs under Article 224 (2) in conjunction with Paragraph (1) of the RS CC and the criminal offence of Forging Documents under Article 377 (2) of the RS CC and sentenced to a compound prison term of five years and one month; currently in custody under the Decision by the Court of B-H number: X-KRN-08/572 of 28 August 2008, which may last until 23 February 2012,

IS GUILTY

Because:

In early 2008, while on the run for having perpetrated the criminal offence of Illicit Production and Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs under Article 224 of the RS Criminal Code, **Željko Ilić** organised and led an organised criminal group referred to in Article 1 (19) of the Criminal Code of Bosnia and Herzegovina (the CC of B-H), which operated until late August 2008 and which was organised for the purpose of illicit international sale, transfer, transport, possession, intercession in further international sale, shipment and delivery of narcotic drug Marijuana - Skunk, which under the Convention on Psychotropic Substances from 1971 and Decision on the List of Narcotic Drugs (*Official Gazette of the Republic of B-H, number 2/92 and 13/94*) was proclaimed a narcotic drug and which can be sold solely upon the authorisation by a relevant body in accordance with the Law on Production and Sale of Narcotic Drugs (*Official Gazette of the Republic of B-H, number 2/92 and 13/94*), which sale is prohibited under the Law on Prevention and Suppression of the Abuse of Narcotic Drugs (*Official Gazette of B-H number 8/06*), from the territory of the Republic of Montenegro to the territory of Bosnia and Herzegovina for the purpose of further sale in the territory of Bosnia and Herzegovina and further transfer, intercession and sale in the territory of the Republic of Croatia; and Zdravko Jurković and several persons known to him from the area of Bosnia and Herzegovina together with Igor Krstović from Montenegro joined this organised criminal group, thus forming the organised criminal group that perpetrated the above mentioned offences of Illicit International Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs during the period from February 2008 until late August 2008, in as much as:

1. Željko Ilić and Zdravko Jurković with several persons known to them – together

Željko Ilić, in collusion with Igor Krstović from Montenegro, as of February 2008 continuously transferred pre-agreed quantities and types of narcotic drug Marijuana – Skunk, of agreed quality and price, which **Željko Ilić** ordered from Igor Krstović, whereupon Igor Krstović would organise unidentified persons known to him to pack and transfer it across the border from the Republic of Montenegro to Bosnia and Herzegovina, and **Željko Ilić** organised its further takeover and distribution in the territory of Bosnia and Herzegovina as well as further in the territory of the Republic of Croatia, in the manner that a portion of drugs would be delivered to Zdravko Jurković, a.k.a. Ganfo; **Željko Ilić** and other persons known to them as well as a person he knew by the name of Radivoje Glušac delivered such drugs and collected money; thus, during the referenced period at least 45 kg were delivered to **Zdravko Jurković** on at least four occasions at the price ranging from EURO 200.00 to 1,200.00 per kilogram, which depended on the type or quality of the narcotic drugs, which **Zdravko Jurković** then took over at the hideout near Mile Čoko's old house and at a hideout near the old church in Bobanovo Selo, Stolac municipality where, upon a prior arrangement, it was brought and hidden by **Željko Ilić** and persons known

to him including Radivoje Glušac, which **Zdravko Jurković**, immediately after taking it over from the hideout and upon a prior arrangement with a person he knew by the nickname *Bepo* from the Republic of Croatia, Split municipality, further transported in his passenger motor vehicle to another hideout close to the entrance to Čapljina where he would leave it and notify Bepo by phone who would then take it over through an unidentified person he knew and transfer it from the territory of BiH to the area of Split, the Republic of Croatia, and would subsequently collect payment for drugs, which had been transferred as described, in the manner that Bepo would send him money by bus to Čapljina or Metković.

2. Željko Ilić together with several persons known to him,

Željko Ilić, in collusion with Igor Krstović from Montenegro, as of February 2008 continuously transferred pre-agreed quantities and types of the narcotic drug Marijuana – Skunk, of agreed quality and price, which **Željko Ilić** ordered from Igor Krstović, whereupon Igor Krstović would hire unidentified persons known to them to pack and transfer it across the border from the Republic of Montenegro to Bosnia and Herzegovina and **Željko Ilić** would further organise its takeover and distribution in the territory of both Bosnia and Herzegovina and further on in the territory of the Republic of Croatia, delivering a part of the drug to persons known to him in Zenica, upon a prior arrangement with **Željko Ilić**; the drugs were delivered by persons known to him alone or accompanied by **Željko Ilić** on a number of occasions, mostly using as means of transportation a passengers motor vehicle of the Golf 1 make, red, manufactured in 1982, registration plates 311-T-568, as well as passengers motor vehicle of the Golf 1 make, red, manufactured in 1982, registration plates 690-J-314, stashed in the door padding and under the fenders on both sides of the vehicle; thus during the above period they delivered at least 28 kilograms of narcotic drugs Marijuana, of different quality, at the price ranging from EURO 750.00 to 1,250.00 per kilogram, for which a total of at least EURO 28,000.00 was paid. The narcotic drugs would be unloaded in the yard of the house at #1 Ivana Gundulića Street in Zenica, in the way that a certain person known to him would throw packages with packed narcotic drugs directly into the above house, through the house window, which they would then weight together in the mentioned house and thereupon they would pay for the delivery. On 26 August 2008, during the search of the facilities used by two persons known to him, i.e. the house at #1 Ivana Gundulića Street in Zenica and the house at #43 Masarikova Street in Zenica, 8 kilograms and 948 grams of gross weight of narcotic drugs Marijuana – Skunk (*Cannabis Sativa L.*) were found and seized.

3. Željko Ilić, together with several persons known to him

Željko Ilić, in collusion with Igor Krstović from Montenegro, as of February 2008 continuously transferred pre-agreed quantities and types of narcotic drug Marijuana – Skunk, of agreed quality and price, which **Željko Ilić** ordered from Igor Krstović, whereupon Igor Krstović would organise unidentified persons known to them to pack and transfer it across the border from the Republic of Montenegro to Bosnia and Herzegovina and **Željko Ilić** would further organise its takeover and distribution in the territory of Bosnia and Herzegovina as well as

further on in the territory of the Republic of Croatia, in a manner that a portion of narcotic drug Marijuana, in the quantity of at least 15 kg, which was delivered to Zdravko Jurković and Mile Čoko, was stashed by a person known to him at the place known to him in the vicinity of, that is further down from his family house in Stolac upon the request by **Željko Ilić** and in arrangement with a person known to him, from where a person known to him on at least one occasion further transported narcotic drugs Marijuana in the quantity of at least 10 kg to the area of Banjaluka in the manner that he first got in touch by phone with Jelenko Knežević a.k.a. *Rogonja* from Banjaluka with whom he would agree on the type, quality, quantity and price of the narcotic drug Marijuana, which he offered for delivery, and then, in arrangement with a person known to him, he took it over from him in Stolac and using his passenger motor car of the Golf 1 make, red, manufactured in 1982, registration plates 311-T-568, the drugs, packed in a sports bag, he further transported to Banjaluka where he surrendered it to Jelenko Knežević who personally took over the drugs and put them into his gray passenger motor vehicle and further transported them to a place he knew in order to sell them and acquire unlawful property gain.

4. Željko Ilić together with several persons known to him

A known female person, in collusion with **Željko Ilić**, as of 8 April 2008, when **Željko Ilić** was deprived of liberty under the Decision of the Banjaluka District Court number KPP-01/07P of 5 January 2007 due to grounded suspicion that he perpetrated the criminal offence of Organised Crime under Article 383 a), Paragraph 2 of the RS Criminal Code in conjunction with the criminal offence of Illicit Production and Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs under Article 224 (2) in conjunction with Paragraph 1 of the RS CC and the criminal offence of Forging Documents under Article 377 (2) of the RS CC, took over a lead over the organised criminal group by way of using her privileged position of defence counsel for **Željko Ilić**, with whom she could freely communicate during the entire time of his custody. Following the instructions of **Željko Ilić**, she took over **Ilić's** letter with a phone number of a known person, which letter **Željko Ilić** intended for a person known to him and thus she accepted to get in touch by phone with the known person and pass on to him messages from **Željko Ilić** and pass on back to **Željko Ilić** the answers, information and additional questions as well as requests for clarifications by a person known to him. Thus the referenced person known to him, in the described manner, facilitated free communication between **Željko Ilić** and a person known to him, by having daily communication with **Ilić**, and at least three times a week with a person known to **Ilić**, which pertained to the exchange of information on the quantities and type of the narcotic drugs, for which in the communication a number of coded names were used, more specifically "merchandize", "expensive", "cheap", "truck" "training shoes", "sports equipment; "training suits" which was illicitly sold internationally, and the amounts of money obtained by the sale, and the pending debts for the narcotic drugs taken over from Igor Krstović from Montenegro which had not been paid for by that moment. Shortly after having established the contact with a person known to **Ilić** she also established a direct phone communication with other persons known to **Ilić** in the territory of Bosnia and Herzegovina, and with the suspect Igor Krstović in the territory of the Republic of Montenegro, all in relation to the illicit trafficking in

narcotic drugs Marijuana, that is, in relation to the quantities ordered, quantities delivered, collected payments and payments made to the deliverer Igor Krstović in the Republic of Montenegro as well as for the purpose of direct takeover of a minimum EURO 5,000.00 from the accused Zdravko Jurković, which originates from the illicit trafficking in narcotic drug Marijuana.

Therefore,

The accused Željko Ilić organised a criminal group referred to in Article 1 (19) of the CC of B-H composed of the accused Zdravko Jurković and other persons known to them, which was organised for the purpose of perpetrating the criminal offence of Illicit Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs under Article 195 (1) of the CC of B-H, and as the organiser, by actions described under Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 he carried out illicit international purchase and organised the transfer, transport, possession, mediation in the further international sale, shipment and delivery of the narcotic drug Marijuana - Skunk“;

Whereby he committed:

the criminal offence of Organised Crime under Article 250 (3) of the Criminal Code of Bosnia and Herzegovina, in conjunction with the criminal offence of Illicit Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs under Article 195 (1) of the CC of B-H and all as read with Article 54 of the CC of B-H.

Thus, pursuant to the above mentioned Articles and by applying Articles 39, 42, 49 and 50 of the CC of B-H the Court has sentenced him to a prison term of **six (6) years and six (6) months** for the referenced criminal offence,

and therefore, considering the prison term of **five years and one month**, which was already imposed on him by the Verdict by the Banjaluka District Court number 011-0-K-08-000-006-P of 8 July 2008 and pursuant to Article 55 (1) of the CC of B-H,

based on the above mentioned legal provisions and applying Article 53 (2), (a) of the B-H CC, the Court

SENTENCES HIM TO

A COMPOUND PRISON TERM OF ELEVEN (11) YEARS

Pursuant to Article 56 of the CC of B-H the time that the accused Željko Ilić has spent in custody under the Decision by this Court number X – KRN – 08/572 as of the day when he was deprived of liberty on 26 August 2008 until he is committed to serve the sentence shall be credited towards the imposed prison term.

Pursuant to the same Article the time the accused Željko Ilić spent in custody under the Decision by the Banjaluka District Court number 011 – 0 – Kpp – 07 –

000 001 – p, starting from 8 April 2008 until 8 July 2008 shall also be credited towards the imposed prison sentence.

Pursuant to Article 396 of the CPC of B-H in conjunction with Article 110 (1) of the CC of B-H the property gain in the amount of BAM 5,000.00 shall be forfeited from the accused.

Pursuant to Article 188 (1) of the Criminal Procedure Code of B-H, the accused must reimburse the costs of the criminal proceedings at the scheduled amount of BAM 300.00.

Reasoning

By the Indictment number KT-339/08 of 20 February 2009, which was confirmed on 23 February 2009 and amended on 11 August 2009, the Prosecutor's Office of Bosnia and Herzegovina charged Željko Ilić with the Organised Crime under Article 250 (3) of the Criminal Code of Bosnia and Herzegovina (the CC of B-H), in conjunction with the criminal offence of Illicit Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs under Article 195 (1) of the CC of B-H.

On 2 July 2009, the accused Željko Ilić and his defence counsel, lawyer Midhat Kočo entered into a Plea Agreement with the Prosecutor of the Prosecutor's Office of B-H Diana Kajmaković, and submitted the Agreement to the Court for consideration.

Pursuant to Article 231 of the CPC of B-H, the Court deliberated on the concluded Plea Agreement. According to the Agreement the accused pleaded guilty to the criminal offence of Organised Crime under Article 250 (3) of the CC of B-H, in conjunction with the criminal offence of Illicit Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs under Article 195 (1) of the CC of B-H, as charged under the Indictment. The Agreement proposed that the accused be sentenced to a prison term of six (6) years and six (6) months for the perpetrated criminal offence and that the proceeds from crime in the amount of BAM 5,000.00 be forfeited from him, as well as that the accused Željko Ilić be bound to testify on all facts he knows about the referenced criminal case and all perpetrators, co-perpetrators and accomplices of those offences that he is aware of and in which he himself possibly took part, as well as that the accused agrees that in case the Court does not relive him of the duty to reimburse the costs of the criminal proceedings, he will reimburse the costs of the criminal proceedings determined by the Court.

During the plea agreement hearing, the Court established that the accused entered into the Agreement voluntarily, consciously and with understanding and having been informed of the possible consequences, including potential claims under property law and costs of the criminal proceedings, the Court established that there is enough evidence proving the guilt of the accused as well as that the accused understood that he would waive his right to trial and that he may not appeal the criminal sanction to be imposed on him.

During the hearing for the pronouncement of the criminal sanction held on 22 September 2009, and after the accused met all his obligations specified in the

Agreement and after the Court accepted the mentioned Agreement, the Prosecutor of the Prosecutor's Office of B-H emphasized that the Prosecution, when proposing the criminal sanction specified in the Agreement, took into account the assistance by the accused in clearing up the referenced criminal offences, proper conduct of the accused during the investigation and hearing, his remorse for the perpetrated criminal offense, as well as the fact that he has a family and, the financial situation that his family will face. As an aggravating circumstance the prosecutor mentioned that the accused was convicted before of the same offences and offenses of the same type. Finally, the prosecutor emphasised that having in mind that the accused did not serve the sentence that he had been imposed before, a compound prison sentence and forfeiture of property gain wouldl achieve the general as well as the special purpose of punishment. The defence counsel for the accused, lawyer Midhat Kočo agreed with all allegations by the prosecutor and added that the accused fully admitted the offences and that not a gram of drugs had ever been found in this case. Moreover, the defence counsel submits that the Court should take into account that his client was a young man when the war started and that he was wounded several times during the war and that due to difficult living conditions he could not provide for his family. Finally, the defence counsel emphasized that the accused was a family man and moved the Court to impose a compound sentence of ten years of imprisonment.

Following deliberation and voting the Court fully accepted the Plea Agreement finding that all requirements referred to in Article 231 (6) of the CPC of B-H have been met.

The Court established that all these pieces of evidence completely confirm the guilt of the accused. The conclusion that the accused committed criminal offences that he is charged with particularly stems from the photo-documentation by the Federation Ministry of Interior number: 09-14/4-51/08 of 29 August 2008 on search of THE house at #43 Masarikova Street; photo-documentation by the Federation Ministry of Interior number: 09-14/4-256 of 29 August 2008 on search of family house and family facilities of Andrea Kogoj and Sabro Ramić and Record on Search of Dwellings, Other Premises and Movable Property by the Federation Administration of Police, Crime Police Sector, number 13/4-9/08 of 26 August 2008; Record of Questioning of Suspect Željko Ilić, number KT-339/08 of 27 August 2008 and 16 December 2008; Record of Questioning of Suspect Zdravko Jurković, number KT – 339/08 of 23 September 2008; Findings of Search of Contents of Telephones, SIM Cards, PCs and Memory Medias by the RS Ministry of Interior, Crime Police Administration, Željko Trninić, of 30 September 2008 and Transcripts of Conversation between the accused Željko Ilić and Igor Krstović from Montenegro and Zdravko Jurković and other persons as well as between Mile Čoko, a.k.a. *Daidža* and another person, which transcripts are corroborated by other material documentation, i.e. by recordings from CDs, from which it clearly stems that the accused Željko Ilić organised and led the organised criminal group that Zdravko Jurković and several persons known to him from the territory of Bosnia and Herzegovina joined to together with Igor Krstović from Montenegro, which was organised for the purpose of illicit international trafficking in the narcotic drug Marijuana – Skunk from the territory of the Republic of Montenegro to the territory of Bosnia and Herzegovina for the purpose of its further sale in the territory of Bosnia and Herzegovina and the Republic of Croatia. The referenced organised criminal group carried out illicit international trafficking in narcotic drugs during the period from February 2008 until late August 2008, in a manner

that the accused Željko Ilić, in direct concert with Igor Krstović from Montenegro, continuously transferred the pre-agreed quantities and types of the narcotic drug Marijuana – Skunk, which the accused ordered from Igor Krstović who would organise its transfer across the border from the Republic of Montenegro to Bosnia and Herzegovina, while the accused Ilić further organised its take-over and distribution in the territory of Bosnia and Herzegovina and further in the territory of the Republic of Croatia as described under Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the operative part of the Verdict.

The Court established that these pieces of evidence fully confirm the culpability of the accused and having in mind the admission by the accused and the results of the proffered evidence as well as that there were no objections against presented evidence, the Court established that the accused Željko Ilić committed the criminal offence of Organised Crime under Article 250 (3) of the CC of B-H in conjunction with the criminal offence of Illicit Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs under Article 195 (1) of the CC of B-H as described in the operative part of the Verdict, of which it found him guilty.

On 22 September 2009, by applying Articles 39, 42, 49 and 50 of the CC of B-H the Court sentenced the accused Željko Ilić to a prison term of six (6) years and six (6) months for the referenced criminal offence, which sentence is proportional to the gravity of perpetrated criminal offence and the degree of criminal liability of the accused as well as to the fact that it was determined by the referenced Plea Agreement that the Court completely accepted. Taking into account the prison term of five (5) years and one (1) month, which was already pronounced by the Banjaluka District Court Verdict number 011-O-K-08-000-006-P of 8 July 2008, which sentence the accused did not serve, pursuant to Article 55 (1) and Article 53 (2) (b) of the CC of B-H the Court sentenced the accused to a compound term of eleven (11) years of imprisonment.

When deciding on a compound sentence, as mitigating circumstances pertaining to the accused, the Court considered his personal and family situation, i.e. the fact that he is a family man, father of two underage children as well as poor financial standing of the family (his wife is unemployed and supports herself and children with father's pension), which circumstance were stated by the accused and which the Prosecution at no rate either disputed or cast doubts on, so the Court found them to be indisputably established.

As an aggravating circumstance pertaining to the accused, the Court finds that he was sentenced on several occasions before for various criminal offences, which stems from the criminal record that is included in the case-file, as well as that the accused is involved in the referenced criminal offence for quite some time, for which purpose he also organised a group to perpetrate the criminal offence, as well as that the earlier Verdict by the Banjaluka District Court, under which he was found guilty and sentenced for the same criminal offence, had no corrective effect on him to deter him from perpetrating the same or similar criminal offences. Instead, by perpetrating the same criminal offence that he was found guilty of and sentenced by this Court, the accused demonstrated an extremely high degree of criminal liability that transforms into an inclination to criminal offences, so the

Court sentenced the accused to a compound prison term of 11 years, which is a bit less than the legal maximum prescribed in Article 53 (2) (b) of the CC of B-H. Due to everything mentioned above, the Court believes that such punishment shall have corrective effect on the accused and deter him from perpetrating criminal offences in the future, as well as deter other potential perpetrators from perpetrating criminal offences. This punishment definitely raises awareness among the citizens of the detrimental and disastrous consequences of criminal offences and of the justifiability, i.e. fairness of punishing the perpetrators. It also constitutes a unique expression of the community's condemnation of the perpetrated criminal offence. Thus, the purpose of punishment prescribed by Article 39 of the Criminal Code of B-H is completely achieved.

Pursuant to Article 56 (1) of the CC of B-H the time that the accused Željko Ilić has spent in custody under the Decision by the Court number X – KRN – 08/572 as of the day he was deprived of liberty on 26 August 2008 until he is committed to serve the sentence, as well as the time he spent in custody under the decision of the Banjaluka District Court number 011 – 0 – Kpp – 07 – 000 001 – p, starting from 8 April 2008 until 8 July 2008 shall be credited towards the imposed sentence.

Pursuant to Article 110 (1) and (2) of the CC of B-H and Article 396 (1) and (2) of the CPC of B-H, proceeds from crime in the amount of BAM 5,000.00 that the Court determined based on the Plea Agreement number KT – 339/08 of 2 July 2009 shall be forfeited from the accused and the accused and his defence counsel agreed to accept the determined amount of acquired illegal gain, as specified above.

Pursuant to Article 188 (1) in conjunction with Article 185 (2) (g) of the CPC of B-H, and pursuant to Article VII of the Agreement the accused must reimburse the costs of the criminal proceedings in the amount of BAM 300.00 scheduled by the Court having in mind the complexity and length of the proceedings as well as the financial standing of the accused.
