

**WEEKLY ACTIVITIES OF THE COURT OF BiH**  
**Section I and II**  
**(30 August 2010 – 3 September 2010)**

**MONDAY, 30 August 2010**

**Friday, 27 August 2010<sup>1</sup>**

- The Court issued a decision in the **Zvonko Perić et al. (X-K-10/876-1)** case extending the custody of the accused Dragan Orbović. Pursuant to this Decision the custody may last pending the completion of main trial but not longer than two years as of the day of confirmation of the Indictment i.e. until 24 August 2012. The next review will be on 27 October 2010.
- In the following cases the Court reviewed the justification of prohibiting measures:
  - **Adis Abaz et al. (X-KRN-09/727)** in relation to the suspects **Adis Sejdić** and **Adnan Selimić**, precisely: house arrest and the ban on travelling outside BiH including temporary seizure of valid travel documents; ban on the issuance of new ones and the ban on the use of the ID card for crossing the BiH state border; mandatory reporting to the relevant Police Station, and in relation to the suspect **Husnija Mušić**: house arrest; ban on travelling and the ban on meeting with suspects in this case;
  - **Muhamed Marić et al. (X-KRN-10/892)** in relation to the suspect Nedžad Delić, precisely: the ban on conducting any business activities related to companies “TEF” d.o.o. Sarajevo and “Granit” d.d. Jablanica; ban on contacting other suspects in this case, as well as potential accomplices, aiders and witnesses, and especially the employees of legal entities of “TEF” d.o.o. Sarajevo and “Granit” d.d. Jablanica.  
The Court found that measures are still justified. The next review will be held on 27 October 2010.
- The Court issued the Decision in **Dario Perić et al. (X-KRN-10/876)** case to terminate the custody of the suspect Hamdija Rizvanbegović and to impose the following prohibiting measures: house arrest and the ban on travelling including the ban on issuance of the new passport as well as the ban on use of ID card for crossing the state border; ban on meeting other suspects in this case; mandatory reporting to the relevant Police station, once a week. The next review will be on 27 October 2010.
- In **Dejan Tuleković et al. (X-KRN-10/973)** case the Court issued the Decision terminating the custody of the suspect Emir Hadžipašić and imposing the following prohibiting measures: house arrest; mandatory reporting to the relevant Police Station, every Monday; ban on meeting other suspects in this case as well as the Prosecution witnesses and third parties who might have the knowledge about this criminal proceeding. The next review will be on 26 October 2010.
- The Court confirmed the Indictment in **Slavko Vučurević et al. (X-K-10/1041)** case charging Slavko Vučurević, Slobodan Popara and Velezar Paranos with the criminal offence of Organized Crime in conjunction with the criminal offence of Illicit Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs. In relation to the accused Vučurević and Popara the Court issued the Decision extending their custody. Pursuant to this Decision the custody may last pending the completion of the main trial but not longer than two years as of the day of confirmation of the Indictment i.e. until 27 August 2012. The next review will be on 27 October 2010.

**Monday, 30 August 2010**

- In **Mensur Memić et al. (X-KR-09/786-1)** case the Court reviewed justification of custody of the

accused Mensur Memić, Dževad Salčin, Senad Hakalović and Nihad Bojadžić and found that the grounds for custody still exist. The next review will be on 30 October 2010.

- The Court reviewed the justification of prohibiting measures in **Arif Adilović et al. (X-K-10/913)** case in relation of the accused Adnan Hamzić, precisely: the suspect is allowed to move within the territory of the Canton of Sarajevo i.e. the suspect is allowed to leave his place of residence and to move within the territory of the Canton of Sarajevo in order to perform business activities in his own company. The measure of daily check-ups by authorized police officers of the relevant Police Station, whether the suspect's home address is, shall remain in force. Other parts of the Court's Decision of 28 April 2010 remain unchanged. The Court found that the grounds for the measures still exist. The next review will be on 30 October 2010.
- In **Josip Grmača (X-KRN-10/956)** case the Court issued the Decision partially upholding the motion of the suspect Josip Grmača whereby the Court's Decision of 30 June 2010 was modified in the way that the temporary seized ID card is to be returned to the suspect. The ID card shall be returned to the suspect after the State Border Agency of BiH notifies the measure of the ban on the use of the ID card for crossing the state border. Other measures remain unchanged. The next review will be on 30 October 2010.

## TUESDAY, 31 August 2010

- At the plea hearing before Section II for Organized Crime, Economic Crime and Corruption of the Court, in **Arif Adilović et al. (X-K-10/913)** case all accused pleaded not guilty. Arif Adilović, Adnan Hamzić and Fuad Memović are charged with the criminal offence of Organized Crime in conjunction with the criminal offence of Illicit Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs, while the accused Adilović and Hamzić are also charged with the criminal offence of Forgery of a Document and aiding thereto (Adilović).
- The Court issued the Decision in **Dejan Tuleković et al. (X-KRN-10/973)** case extending custody of the suspects Dejan Tuleković and Mile Majstorović for one month. Pursuant to this Decision the custody may last until 2 October 2010 or until the Court renders a different decision.

- In **Milenko Topalović et al. (X-KRN-10/1036)** case the Court issued the Decision ordering the suspect Milenko Topalović into one-month pre-trial custody. Pursuant to this Decision the custody may last until 28 September 2010. Milenko Topalović is suspected of the criminal offence of Organized Crime in conjunction with the criminal offence of Illegal Trafficking in Arms and Military Equipment and Products of Dual Usage.

### WEDNESDAY, 1 September 2010

- In **Muradif Hamzabegović et al. (X-KRN-09/854)** case the Court issued the Decision terminating custody of the suspect Nihad Brčaninović and imposing the following prohibiting measures: ban on meeting the other suspects and witnesses in this case; and order to report once a week, precisely each Monday, to the relevant police station; seizure of the driver's license of Nihad Brčaninović. The next review will be held on 1 November 2010.
- In **Miodrag Jeftić et al. (X-K-10/889)** case the Court pronounced the trial verdict dismissing the charges due to the lack of jurisdiction of the Court in relation to the accused: Miodrag Jeftić and Dušan Lukić, and due to the Prosecution's dropping of charges in relation to the accused Dragan Dragičević. Miodrag Jeftić and Dušan Lukić were charged with the criminal offence of Unauthorized Production and Sale of Intoxicating Drugs of the Criminal Code of RS, while Dragan Dragičević was charged with the criminal offense of Organized Crime in conjunction with the criminal offence of Illicit Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs of the CC BiH.
- In **Ante Kovač (X-KRŽ-08/489)** case the Court conducted the review of justification of custody of the accused Ante Kovač, and found that the grounds for custody still exist. The next review will be held on 2 November 2010.

#### THURSDAY, 2 September 2010

- In **Alija Osmić (X-KR-09/781-1)** case the Court passed the Decision partially modifying the Decision on prohibiting measures of 22 April 2010 in the way that the following measures are ordered: house arrest; withdrawal of the travel documents and the ban on issuance of new travel documents, and the ban on use of ID card for crossing of the state border of Bosnia and Herzegovina; mandatory reporting to the relevant police station once a day, ban on the accused from meeting or contacting, directly or indirectly, any potential suspects or witnesses in this case; ban on discussing the case with anyone but his Defense Counsel.
- In **Jasko Šabić (X-K-10/949)** case, following the deliberation and accepting of the plea agreement entered between the Prosecutor's Office of BiH and the accused Jasko Šabić, the Court pronounced the verdict finding the accused Šabić guilty of the criminal offence of Giving Gifts and Other Forms of Benefits and sentenced him to a suspended sentence with imposed imprisonment of four months and concurrently ordering that the sentence will not be executed unless the accused Šabić commits a new crime within one year as of the day the verdict becomes binding.
- In **Dragan Mikulić et al. (X-K-05/164)** case the Court passed the Decision refusing the motion for retrial of the convicted Dragan Mikulić and Mikulić Company d.o.o. Grude.
- In **Zejid Šabić (X-K-08/474-11)** case, ruling on the motion for quasi-reopening of the criminal proceedings the Court passed the verdict to take as determined the sentences imposed in other cases, and consequently Zejid Šabić has been sentenced to a single imprisonment sentence for a term of seven years and 11 months.
- In **Dragan Damjanović (X-KR-05/107)** case the Court passed the Decision refusing the motion for retrial of the convicted Dragan Damjanović.
- In **Dario Perić et al. (X-KRN-10/876)** case the Court passed the Decision to terminate custody of the suspects Luka Raguž and Šime Šljivić, and imposed the following prohibiting measures on them: house arrest and ban from travelling with the ban on issuance of a new passport, as well as the use of the ID card for crossing the state border; the ban on meeting certain individuals; mandatory reporting to the competent police station, once a week.
- In **Davor Jurković et al. (X-KRN-10/940)** case the Court carried out the review of justification of the prohibiting measures in relation to the suspect Davor Jurković, precisely: house arrest, ban from travelling with seizure of the travel document and the ban on issuance of a new passport and

ban from using the ID cards for crossing the state border; mandatory reporting to the relevant police station, once a week. The Court found that the measures are still justified. The next review will be held on 2 November 2010.

Mensur Memić, Dževad Salčin, Nedžad Hodžić and Nihad Bojadžić are charged with the criminal offences of War Crimes against Civilians and War Crimes against Prisoners of War while the accused Senad Hakalović is charged with the criminal offence of War Crimes against Civilians.
- **Saša Danijel Grabež et al. (X-K-09/851-1)** commencement of the main trial before Section II for Organized Crime, Economic Crime and Corruption of the Court, starting at 1:00 p.m. in Courtroom 8. Saša Danijel Grabež, Dušan Tejić and Milovan Đukić are charged with the criminal offence of Organized Crime in conjunction with the criminal offence of Illicit Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs.
- **Trpimir Miletić et al. (X-K-10/981)** commencement of the main trial before Section II for Organized Crime, Economic Crime and Corruption of the Court, starting at 1:00 p.m. in Courtroom 5. Trpimir Mišetić is charged with the criminal offense of Abuse of Office or Authority, while Zdenko Bebek is charged with the criminal offense of Accessory after the Fact.
- **Franc Kos et al. (X-KR-10/893-1)** arraignment before Section I for War Crimes of the Court, starting at 10.00 a.m. in Courtroom 8. Franc Kos, Stanko Kojić, Vlastimir Golijan and Zoran Goronja are charged with the criminal offense of Genocide.
