Monday, 30 November 2009

- Having considered and accepted the Statement on the admission of guilt signed by the Prosecutor's Office of BiH and the accused, the Preliminary Hearing Judge of the Section II of the Court delivered a First-instance Verdict in the **Dragan Vidović et al. (X-K-09/713-1)** case finding the accused Dragan Vidović, Dragan Banjac and Zdravko Janić guilty of the continued criminal offence of Illicit Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs (the CC of BiH). The accused Dragan Vidović and Dragan Banjac were each sentenced to punishment of four years and eight months of imprisonment while the accused Zdravko Janić was sentenced to punishment of one year of imprisonment. The Court also issued a Decision on terminating custody of the accused Dragan Vidović, Dragan Banjac and Zdravko Janić.
- The Court reviewed justification of prohibitive measures in the **Muhamed Ibrahimović (X-KRN-09/663)** case for Muhamed Ibrahimović, suspected of the criminal offence of Obstruction of Justice. The measures include: ban on meeting or communicating in any manner with a suspect in this case and his family members and relatives, as well as with witnesses and their family members as well as with other persons who might be either as witnesses or suspects linked to this criminal offence. The Court found that reasons for the measures still remain. The next review will be on 30 January 2010.
- The Court issued a Decision in the **Bojan Cvijan et al. (X-KRN-09/707)** case terminating custody of the suspects Bojan Cvijan, Muhamed Ramić, Marko Krajišnik and Admir Hodžić and imposing prohibitive measures which include: ban on leaving the place of residence (house arrest); temporary seizure of all travel documents with the ban on the issuance of the new ones as well as the ban on the usage of the ID card for crossing the BiH state border; ban on contacting or linking in any manner with co-suspects, potential helpers and accomplices in the perpetration of the criminal offence in subject; ban on discussion about the case with anyone except their Defence Lawyers. The review of the measures will be on 30 January 2010. Bojan Cvijan, Muhamed Ramić, Marko Krajišnik and Admir Hodžić are suspected of the criminal offence of Organized Crime in conjunction with the criminal offence of Illicit Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs and other.

TUESDAY, 1 December 2009

- The Court delivered a Second-instance Verdict in the **Elvir Haračić (X-KŽ-08/631)** case dismissing the appeals and confirming the First-instance Verdict of 30 March 2009 by which the accused Elvir Haračić was found guilty of the criminal offence of Illicit Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs and sentenced to one year and one month of imprisonment.

WEDNESDAY, 2 December 2009

- The Court reviewed justification of prohibitive measures in the **Siniša Egić et al. (X-KRN-07/472)** case for Siniša Egić who is together with Zdravko Janić, Miroslav Pejčinović, Dalibor Knežević, Dario Vidović, Rajko Obrenović and Davor Jokić suspected of the criminal offence of Organized Crime in conjunction with the criminal offence of Abuse of Office or Official Authority. The measures include: regular reporting to the Police Station of Lazarevo, Banja Luka, ban on leaving the place of residence and the ban on travelling outside BiH, temporary seizure of all valid passports issued in the name of the suspect as well as the seizure of a driver's license; ban on the issuance of the new passport as well as the ban on the usage of the ID card for

crossing the state border, ban on visiting places, locations where suspects might get in contact with one another as well as in contact with witnesses, ban on meeting with witnesses. The Court found that reasons for the measures still remain. The next review will be on 2 February 2010.

THURSDAY, 3 December 2009

- The Court dispatched the Second-instance Verdict dated 9 November 2009 of the Appellate Panel of the Section I for War Crimes of the Court in the **Miladin Stevanović (X-KRŽ-05/24-2)** case. By the Verdict of the Appellate Panel the First-instance Verdict dated 29 July 2008 was confirmed by which the accused Miladin Stevanović was acquitted of all charges.
- The Court issued a Decision in the **Nedžad Hodžić et al. (X-KRN-09/786)** case extending custody of Nihad Bojadžić, suspected of the criminal offence of War Crimes against Civilians and the criminal offence of War Crimes against Prisoners of War to two months. Pursuant to the Decision custody may last until 3 February 2010.
- The Court issued a Decision in the **Adis Abaz et al. (X-KRN-09/727)** case extending custody of Adis Abaz, Mijo Grgić and Husnija Mušić to two months. Adis Abaz, Mijo Grgić and Husnija Mušić are suspected of the criminal offence of Organized Crime in conjunction with the criminal offence of Illicit Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs and the criminal offence of Illegal Trafficking in Weapons and Military Equipment and Products of Dual Use. Pursuant to the Decision custody in relation to the suspect Adis Abaz may last until 9 January 2010, while custody in relation to the suspects Mijo Grgić and Husnija Mušić may last until 5 January 2010.

FRIDAY, 4 December 2009

- The Court issued a Decision in the **Vitomir Nježić et al. (X-KRN-08/643)** case ordering Vitomir Nježić, suspected of the criminal offence of Organized Crime in conjunction with the criminal offence of Smuggling of Persons into one-month custody. Pursuant to the Decision custody may last until 2 January 2010.
- Students from Faculty of Philosophy in Mostar, Department of Psychology, visited the Court and the Office of the Prosecutor of BiH. The students wanted to get the insight into the work of these institutions. The presentations by representatives of Legal Department, Court Management, Witness Support Section and Public Information and Outreach Section gave students the insight into the structure of the Court, technical aspects of trials, Law on witnesses and the role of psychologists in witness support program. The representative of the Office of the Prosecutor spoke about investigation phase and the role of the witnesses.
