MONDAY, 6 July 2009

Friday 3 July 2009¹

- The Court reviewed justification of custody in the following cases:
 - **Salih Alibašić et al. (X-K-07/436)** for the Accused Salih Alibašić
 - **Ante Tomas and Another (X-K-08/566-1)** for the Accused Ante Tomas and Mario Jukić

The Court found that the reasons for custody still remain. The next review will be on 3 September 2009.

- On 30 June 2009 upon the final Decision of the Court of 17 June 2009, the case of **Safet Bukvić (X-KR-09/705)** was transferred to the relevant Court in Mostar.

Monday 6 July 2009

- The Court issued a Decision in the **Blagoje Golubović (X-KR-08/494-1)** on terminating custody of the Accused Blagoje Golubović and releasing him from custody accordingly.
- Following the deliberation and acceptance of the Plea Agreement in the **Zdravko Jurković (X-K-08/572-2)** case, the Court pronounced a verdict finding the Accused Zdravko Jurković guilty of the criminal offence of Organized Crime in conjunction with the criminal offence of Illicit Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs, and sentenced him to a 2-year imprisonment. The Court also seized the material benefit gained by the perpetration of the criminal offence from the Accused Jurković in the amount of EUR 2,500.00.
- The Court issued a Decision in the **Željko Ilić et al. (X-K-08/572-1)** on separating the case therefore the case in relation to the Accused Željko Ilić will be processed under the case number of **Željko Ilić (X-K-08/572-3)**, while in relation to the Accused Marica Ćulum, Nikola Glušac, Boris Samardžić, Ilija Bjeletić, Ante Prce, Sabro Ramić and Andrea Kogoj will be processed under the case number of **Marica Ćulum et al. (X-K-08/572-1)**.
- The Court reviewed justification of prohibitive measures in the **Stojanka Garić et al. (X-KRN-07/454)** case for the Suspects Stojanka Garić and Vera Kasavica which include: regular reporting to the relevant Police Station, ban on contacting or interfering in any manner with persons who are potential witnesses or suspects in this case, ban on discussing about the case with anyone except with their Lawyers and strict compliance with the Court's demands. Stojanka Garić and Vera Kasavica are suspected of the criminal offence of Organized Crime in conjunction with the criminal offence of Abuse of Office or Official Authority. The next review will be on 6 September 2009. Within the same case custody of the Suspect Boban Nikolić expired but the Suspect is still held in the extradition detention before the Section III for General Crime of the Court.
- The Court reviewed justification of custody in the **Milorad Trbić (X-KR-07/386)** case for the Accused Milorad Trbić. The Court found that the reasons for custody still remain. The next review will be on 6 September 2009.

TUESDAY, 7 July 2009

- The Court reviewed justification of prohibitive measures in the **Wu Qiyu et al. (X-KRN-07/468)** case for Wu Qiyu, Wang Chengsheng and Wu Qijin, being suspected of the criminal offence of Money Laundering and the criminal offence of Tax Evasion. The Court found that the reasons for the measures which include: ban on traveling outside Bosnia and Herzegovina and temporary seizure of travel documents still remain. The next review will be on 6 September 2009.
- Following deliberation of the plea agreement in the **Zoran Babić et al. (X-KR-08/549)** case the Court dismissed the plea agreement between the Prosecutor's Office of BiH and the Accused Gordan Đurić, being charged with the criminal offence of Crimes against Humanity.

WEDNESDAY, 8 July 2009

- The Court reviewed justification of prohibitive measures in the **Admir Ahmetpahić et al. (X-KRN-08/591)** case for the Suspect Admir Ahmetpahić. The Court found that the reasons for the measures still remain. The measures include: ban on visiting premises of a shopping center "FIS" in Vitez; ban on meeting with the Suspect Suvad Đidić and his family members and relatives, with Amir Ibrahim and his family members and relatives, as well as meeting with the employees of a shopping center "FIS" in Vitez; regular reporting to the Police Station of Centar, Zenica. Admir Ahmetpahić is suspected of the criminal offence of Terrorism. The next review will be on 8 September 2009.
- The Court issued a Decision in the **Simo Savić et al. (X-KRN-05/96)** case ordering the Suspect Zoran Marić into one-month custody. Zoran Marić is suspected of the criminal offence of War Crimes against Civilians. Pursuant to the Decision custody may last until 7 August 2009.

THURSDAY, 9 July 2009

- On 29 June 2009 the Court issued a Decision in the **Agan Kadušić et al. (X-KRN-08/596)** case on separating the case in relation to the Suspects Agan Kadušić, Abedin Vesnić, Ante Bašić, Daver Morina, Fuad Dizdarević, Marinko Bašić and Zoran Bašić will be processed under the case number **Agan Kadušić et al. (X-KRN-08/596-1)**, while in relation to the Suspects Adisa Jusić Radmanović, Alija Yener, Angela Čubelić, Ismail Uysala and Mustafa Katarci will be processed under the case number **Angela Čubelić et al. (X-KRN-08/596)**.

- The Court confirmed the Indictment in the **Agan Kadušić et al. (X-K-08/596-1)** case charging Agan Kadušić, Daver Morina, Marinko Bašić and Zoran Bašić with the criminal offence of Organized Crime in conjunction with the criminal offence of Smuggling of Persons while Abedin Vesnić, Anto Bašić and Fuad Dizdarević are charged with the criminal offence of Smuggling of Persons.
- On 3 July 2009 the Court issued a Decision in the **Admir Ahmetpahić et al. (X-KRN-08/591)** case on separating the case therefore the case in relation to the Suspects Suvad Đidić and Amir Ibrahim will be processed under the case number **Suvad Đidić and Another (X-KRN-08/591-1)**, while in relation to the Suspect Admir Ahmetpahić under the case number **Admir Ahmetpahić (X-KRN-08/591)**.
- The Court confirmed the Indictment in the **Suvad Đidić and Another (X-K-08/591-1)** case charging the Accused Suvad Đidić and Amir Ibrahim with the criminal offence of Terrorism.
- The Court issued a Decision in the **Kenan Kurtović (X-KRN-09/701)** case on terminating custody of the Suspect Kenan Kurtović and imposing prohibitive measures which include: ban on leaving place of residence including seizure of all personal identification documents, ID card and BiH passport and the ID card of the Republic of Serbia; ban on contacting and meeting with a witness, obligation to report to the Police Station of Centar Sarajevo. Kenan Kurtović is suspected of the criminal offence of Organized Crime in conjunction with the criminal offence of Illicit Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs and the criminal offence under Article 52(1)a) of the Canton Sarajevo Weapons Law.
- The Court issued a Decision in the **Mladen Blagojević (X-KRŽ-06/263)** case on extending custody of the Accused Mladen Blagojević to six months. Pursuant to the Decision custody may last until 6 February 2010.

FRIDAY, 10 July 2009

- The Court passed a Verdict dismissing the charges in the **Blagoje Golubović (X-KR-08/494-1)** case. The Verdict points out, among other things, that on 6 July 2009, the Prosecutor's Office of BiH filed a written submission notifying the Court that they dropped the charges against the accused Blagoje Golubović.
- The Court pronounced the first-instance Verdict in the **Ante Kovač (X-KR-08/489)** case, by which the Accused Ante Kovač was found guilty of the criminal offence of War Crimes against Civilians. In that regard the Court sentenced him to 13 years of imprisonment. Within the same case the Court issued a Decision on extending custody of the Accused Ante Kovač to additional nine months. Pursuant to the Decision custody may last until 10 April 2010.
