

WEEKLY ACTIVITIES OF THE COURT OF BiH
Section I and II
(26 July 2010 – 30 July 2010)

MONDAY, 26 July 2010

- The Court reviewed justification of custody in the **Marko Adamović et al. (X-KR-05/119)** case for the accused Boško Lukić. The Court found that reasons for custody still remain. The next review will be on 26 September 2010.
- In the **Haris Čaušević et al. (X-KRN-10/995)** case the Court issued a Decision extending the custody of the suspects Haris Čaušević, Naser Palislamović, Emin Osmanagić, Nedžad Keško and Haris Špago to two months. Pursuant to this Decision the custody of the suspect Čaušević may last until 27 September 2010 while the custody for other suspects in this case may last until 28 September 2010.

TUESDAY, 27 July 2010

- The Court reviewed justification of prohibitive measures in the following cases:
 - **Muhamed Marić et al. (X-KRN-10/892)** for the suspect Mirsad Omerika such as: ban on leaving the place of residence without prior consent of the Court; ban on travelling including temporary seizure of the valid travel document-passport issued in the name of the suspect as well as the ban on the issuance of new passports and the ban on the usage of the ID card for crossing the state border; ban on visiting certain places, in specific, business premises of the legal entities of "TEF" d.o.o. Sarajevo and "Granit" d.d. Jablanica, as well as other places where the suspect might get in contact with accomplices, helpers and witnesses; ban on meeting with certain persons as well as contacting with suspects in this case, potential accomplices, helpers and witnesses especially with the employees of the legal entities of "TEF" d.o.o Sarajevo and "Granit" d.d. Jablanica; regular reporting every Monday to the relevant Police Station;
 - **Davor Jurković et al. (X-KRN-10/940)** for the suspect Vanja Ivković such as: ban on leaving the place of residence without prior consent of the Court; seizure of the valid travel document-passport along with the ban on the issuance of new travel documents as well as the ban on the usage of the ID card for crossing the state border of BiH; ban on contacting or interfering in any manner with suspects in this case; regular reporting every other Monday to the relevant Police Station.

The Court found that reasons for the measures still remain. The next review will be on 27 September 2010.

WEDNESDAY, 28 July 2010

- In the **Momir Pelemiš and another (X-KR-08/602)** case the Court reviewed justification of custody for the accused Momir Pelemiš and Slavko Perić. The Court found that reasons for custody still remain. The next review will be on 28 September 2010.
- Students and professors taking part in International Summer School 'Human Rights and Transitional Justice' visited the Court. During the visit, our guests saw the footage from the trial in the **Petar Mitrović et al. (X-KRŽ/05/24-1)** case and spoke to Judge Phillip Weiner and the representative of Public Information and Outreach Section of the Court.

THURSDAY, 29 July 2010

- The Court issued a Decision in the **Momčilo Šešelj and another (X-K-10/872)** case extending the custody of the accused Momčilo Šešelj. Pursuant to this Decision his custody may last up to three years as of the day the Indictment was confirmed i.e. 21 July 2013. The next review will be on 29 September 2010. Within the same case the Court issued a Decision terminating the custody of the accused Risto Vreća and imposing the following prohibitive measures: ban on leaving the place of residence; regular reporting to the relevant Police Station. The next review will be on 29 September 2010.
- In the **Zoran Mijatović et al. (X-KRN-09/846)** case the Court issued a Decision ordering the suspect Saudin Sprečić into one-month custody. Pursuant to this Decision his custody may last until 27 August 2010. Saudin Sprečić is suspected of the criminal offence of Organized Crime in conjunction with the criminal offence of Illicit Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs and the criminal offence of Illegal Trafficking in Weapons and Military Equipment.
- The Court issued a Decision in the **Arif Adilović et al. (X-K-10/913)** case extending the custody of the accused Fuad Memović and Arif Adilović to three years. The next review will be on 29 September 2010.
