MONDAY, 8 December 2008

On Friday 5 December 2008¹

- The Court reviewed motion for extension of custody in the **Admir Ahmetspahić et al. (X-KRN-08/591)** case for the Suspects Admir Ahmetspahić, Suvad Đidić and Amir Ibrahim, since the Appellate Panel of the Section II for Organized Crime, Economic crime and Corruption revoked the first-instance Decision on extension of custody. The Court confirmed its first-instance Decision and issued a Decision on extending custody for Admir Ahmetspahić and Suvad Đidić which may last until 11 December 2008, while custody for Amir Ibrahim may last until 16 January 2009. Admir Ahmetspahić, Suvad Đidić and Amir Ibrahim are suspected of the criminal offence of Terrorism.
- The Court reviewed justification of custody in the **Marko Adamović et al. (X-KR-05/119)** case for the Accused Marko Adamović and Boško Lukić. The Court found that the reasons for custody still remain. The next review will be on 5 February 2009.
- The Court reviewed justification of custody in the **Ratko Bundalo et al. (X-KR-07/419)** case for the Accused Ratko Bundalo. The Court found that the reasons for custody still remain. The next review will be on 5 February 2009.

TUESDAY, 9 December 2008

- The Court reviewed justification of prohibitive measures in the **Gani Kovači et al. (X-K-07/474-1)** case for the Accused Atif Karajić, Damir Karajić, Miodrag Zubac, Jovo Šišković, Borislav Tasovac, Dragan Marković, Zejid Šabić, Muhamed Mahmutović, Musair Đulić, Gani Kovači, Velibor Mrkaić, Radivoje Mrkaić, Muhamed Račić, Fadil Šarić and Momir Zečević. The Court found that the reasons for the measures still remain. The measures include: ban on leaving place of residence and ban on travelling outside BiH, temporary seizure of all valid passports issued in the name of the Accused, ban on the issuance of the new passport as well as the ban on the use of the ID card for crossing the state border, ban on leaving place of residence, e.g. Cazin, Trebinje and Ljubinje; ban on visiting places, locations where Accused might get in contact with one another, as well as in contact with persons whom they allegedly sold the drugs and persons whom they allegedly smuggled, Accused are ordered to regularly report to the Police Stations Cazin, Trebinje and Ljubinje. The next review will be on 9 February 2009.
- The Court confirmed the Indictment in the **Jovo Jandrić and Another (X-KR-05/96)** case charging the Accused Jovo Jandrić and Slobodan Pekez with the criminal offence of War Crimes against Civilians.

WEDNESDAY, 10 December 2008

- The Court issued the Decision in the **Ranko Vuković and Another (X-KRŽ-07/405)** case terminating custody of Ranko and Rajko Vuković and ordering prohibitive measures which include the following: prohibition from leaving the place of residence without prior approval of the Court, except when leaving the place of residence in order to appear before the Court or upon the summons of the Prosecutor's Office of BiH; temporary withdrawal of travel documents, ID cards and driving licenses along with the prohibition of issuance of new travel documents as well as the prohibition to use the identity card for crossing the State border of Bosnia and Herzegovina; reporting to the Foča Public Security Station every Monday and Friday. The first-instance Verdict dated 4 February 2008 found the Accused Ranko and Rajko Vuković guilty of the criminal offence of Crimes against Humanity and both were sentenced to imprisonment in the duration of twelve (12) years. On 2 September 2008, the the Appellate Panel of Section I for War Crimes of the Court handed down the Decision in the Ranko Vuković and another case, by which the first-instance Verdict of the Court was revoked and a retrial before the Appellate Panel ordered for that part of the Verdict. The Appeal of the Prosecutor's Office of BiH was rejected as unfounded and the First-instance Verdict confirmed in the acquitting part. The next review will be on 9 February 2009.
- The Court reviewed justification of prohibitive measures in the **Zoran Tubić (X-KRN-07/474)** case for the Suspect Zoran Tubić which include: ban on leaving place of residence and ban on travelling outside BiH, ban on visiting places, locations where the Suspect might get in contact with one another, ban on meeting with each other and ban on meeting with other persons whom he allegedly sold the drugs and persons whom he allegedly smuggled, regular reporting to the Police Station. Zoran Tubić is suspected of the criminal offence of Organized crime in conjunction with the criminal offence of Smuggling of Persons and Illicit Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs. The next review will be on 10 February 2009.

Pursuant to the Decision custody may last until 11 January 2009. Admir Ahmetspahić, Suvad Đidić and Amir Ibrahimović are suspected of the criminal offence of Terrorism.

- A pronouncement of the Verdict in the **Krešo Lučić (X-KRŽ-06/298)** case has been scheduled for Tuesday 16 December 2008, starting at 1:00p.m. in courtroom 8. On 19 September 2007 the Court pronounced the first-instance Verdict and found the Accused Krešo Lučić guilty of the criminal offence of Crimes against Humanity and sentenced him to six years of imprisonment. On 3 April 2008 the Appellate Panel of the Section I for War Crimes issued a Decision revoking the first-instance Verdict and ordering a new trial before the Appellate Panel. The trial before the Appellate Panel commenced on 16 September 2008.
- A plea hearing in the **Nisvet Duratović et al. (X-K-08/598)** case has been scheduled for Friday 19 December 2008, starting at 12:00p.m. in courtroom 7. Nisvet Duratović, Senad Tahirović and Zijad Halilović are charged with the criminal offence of Smuggling of Persons.
