Based on Article IV.4.a) of the Constitution of Bosnia and Herzegovina, the Parliamentary Assembly of Bosnia and Herzegovina, at the 46th session of the House of Representatives held on 04 November 2004 and at the 40th session of the House of Peoples held on 25 April 2005, adopted the

LAW ON AMENDMENTS TO THE CRIMINAL CODE OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

Article 1

In the Criminal Code of Bosnia and Herzegovina (“Official Gazette Bosnia and Herzegovina” No. 37/03 and 61/04) in Chapter XX – “CRIMINAL OFFENCES AGAINST ADMINISTRATION OF JUSTICE” behind Article 231, new Article 231a shall be added to read as follows:

Article 231a

Whoever, having knowledge of the location of a mass grave, fails to inform of its location, shall be punished by imprisonment for a term not exceeding three years”

Article 2

This law shall enter into force eight days after the date of its publication in the “Official Gazette of Bosnia and Herzegovina”
