Pursuant to Article IV.4. a) of the Constitution of Bosnia and Herzegovina, the Parliamentary Assembly of Bosnia and Herzegovina, at the 82nd session of the House of Representatives, held on July 7th, 2006, and the 60th session of the House of Peoples, held on July 7th, 2006, passed the following

LAW ON AMENDMENTS TO THE LAW ON TRANSFER OF CASES FROM THE ICTY TO THE PROSECUTOR’S OFFICE OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA AND THE USE OF EVIDENCE COLLECTED BY THE ICTY IN PROCEEDINGS BEFORE THE COURTS IN BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

Article 1

Article 8 of the Law on Transfer of Cases from the ICTY to the Prosecutor’s Office of Bosnia and Herzegovina and the Use of Evidence Collected by the ICTY in proceedings pending before the courts in Bosnia and Herzegovina (Official Gazette of BiH, No. 61/04) shall be amended so as to read as follows:

“Article 8

Documents and Forensic Evidence collected by the ICTY

- (1) Original documents, certified copies, certified electronic copies and copies authenticated as unaltered in comparison to their originals and forensic evidence collected by the ICTY shall be used in proceedings before the courts and shall be treated as if they were obtained by competent national authorities.
- (2) The authentication and/or certification of electronic copies, in the sense of paragraph 1 herein, may be performed jointly for more documents or more pages of a single document, and may be performed electronically.
- (3) Certification and authentication in the sense of paragraphs 1 and 2 herein shall be performed by the ICTY.”

Article 2

This Law shall enter into force one day after it has been published in the Official Gazette of BiH.
